"FRUIT CD"



Let's clarify that the 'Fruit CD' set is made up of 6 titles and not 8 as it is often confused; the correct titles are as follows (in alphabetical order):













This six titles have common characteristics which, in addition to determining the correct set, identify the first release from the reprints. Here are the details:

- 1. Back cover without barcode
- 2. On back cover 'Polygram' spelled incorrectly: 'Poligram'
- 3. The picture inside the front folding cover shows Bono with microphone, raised hand on left direction and various colored background (here an example):



- 4. The picture CD similarly shows the picture on the reverse of back cover
- 5. The CD matrix shows the full title followed by 'CD'. ('titleCD' or 'title CD)

Instead both titles below are (improperly) attributed to 'FRUITCD' set, released after the first 6 titles above with these different peculiarities wich, with no dubt, identifies the different manufacturing:





- 1. Back cover shows barcode
- 2. 'Polygram' spelled correctly
- 3. Different picture inside the front folding cover
- 4. Back cover with white reverse
- 5. The CD matrix doesn't shows the full title
